



All visitors must report directly to the main office. At no time are families/visitors allowed to go directly to a classroom/cafeteria/forum without first reporting to the office.

Classroom Supply List

Forms, Forms, Forms

During the first week of school, your child will bring home many forms that will need to be filled out. Please make every effort to complete and return forms as soon as possible. Please pay particular attention to the emergency dismissal form. Include the names of all people who have permission to pick up your child. At no time will a child be dismissed to someone not on the emergency form. Please note, that by listing a person on the form (including father and mother), you are giving permission for that person to dismiss your child unless otherwise noted. In addition, please contact the office in the event of any current protective orders (209As). Thank you for your anticipated cooperation!

Supper Club

Once again this year, Hayden McFadden School will be offering an after school supper program aimed at ensuring all our students have an opportunity to eat a well balanced hot supper. Similar to last year, families will need to sign up their children for Supper Club. Registration forms will be sent home with students within the first full week of school. The Supper Program will run Monday through Friday from 3:30-4:15. Please keep in mind that in order for students to participate in Supper Club they must follow all school rules, display appropriate behavior, attend 5 days a week and stay for the duration of Supper Club (meaning students cannot be dismissed early from supper club), be picked up on time from Supper Club, and want to be in Supper Club. Failure to meet these expectation may result in removal from Supper Club.





Student Arrival and Dismissal



Arrival Locations: Student arrival is between 7:30-7:45 at the designated locations below. Students will not be allowed to enter the school building prior to 7:30 as there is NO supervision. In addition, students need to enter through the designated locations. Students should not be entering through the main office unless they are tardy or they ride a school/daycare bus. Students who arrive late must report to the main office to be marked tardy prior to heading to class.

Grade	Arrival Location
Preschool	Enter through door "M" (Located on Country Street side of the building)
Kindergarten	Enter through door "D" (1st floor cafeteria on the Purchase St. side of the building) and sit in the cafeteria
Grades 1 & 2	Enter through door "D" (1st floor cafeteria on the Purchase St. side of the building) and proceed to the forum.
Grades 3, 4, 5	Enter through door "I" (gymnasium on the Coggeshall St. side of the building)

Dismissal

<u>Dismissal Locations:</u> Student dismissal begins promptly at 3:30. Please note the new dismissal time for the 18-19 school year. All students are expected to be picked up on time at the designated dismissal locations as there is no after school supervision. Families of students that are repeatedly picked up late will be required to meet with administration to resolve the issue. Your anticipated cooperation is greatly appreciated. PLEASE NOTE: Students cannot be dismissed from the office between 3:15-3:30 as dismissal is underway and classrooms/students are in the process of heading to designated dismissal locations.

Grades 2 & 3	Dismissed through door "D" (1st floor cafeteria on the Purchase St. side of the building)	
Grade 4	Dismissed through door "I" (gymnasium on the Coggeshall St. side of the building)	
Grade 5	Dismissed through door "H" (gymnasium on the Coggeshall St. side of the building)	



Breakfast in the Classroom and School Lunch

Once again this year, at no cost to families, Hayden McFadden School will be offering "Breakfast in the Classroom" and free school lunches regardless of family income levels. Each morning, students will eat breakfast together in their classrooms. They will enjoy nutritionally well-balanced foods like breakfast wraps, yogurt, or fruit served directly in their classroom. *Due to food allergies, students are not allowed to bring in breakfast foods, including Dunkin' Donuts, to eat/drink in the morning*. Breakfast will last approximately 15 minutes. Students will then transition into their academic school day. Students will also enjoy a well-balanced lunch. Lunch will be 30 minutes. Please be reminded that there are no soda or glass bottles are allowed in school.

After School New Bedford Parks & Recreation Program

Once again this year, Hayden McFadden, in collaboration with NB Parks & Recreation, will offer an after school program at no charge to families for students in grades 3-5. The program will tentatively start the first week of October. More information will be sent home to families in September.
